Our men's team is currently playing in the 1. Bundesliga Süd (one of the highest German lacrosse leagues). Rookies and new players usually come in via the university, resulting in a large range of lacrosse experience within the team. These rookies have their first contact with the sport of lacrosse, whereas some of our more experienced players have been playing for up to 6 years and more. This variety is mirrored by the average age of the team. Some players are as young as 19 and others are older than 30 years. This results in different players having different levels of experience and understanding of the game. A large part of the team consists of university students who, unfortunately, leave the team when they graduate. A large focus of our team is to quickly and successfully integrate new players into the team which is why we often have team events such as a hiking trip In the last two seasons, we had to cope with many players' leaving and new players' arriving, leading to our having to play against descending to a lower league. Luckily, we managed to succeed both times. Our long-team goal is to participate in the play-offs.
